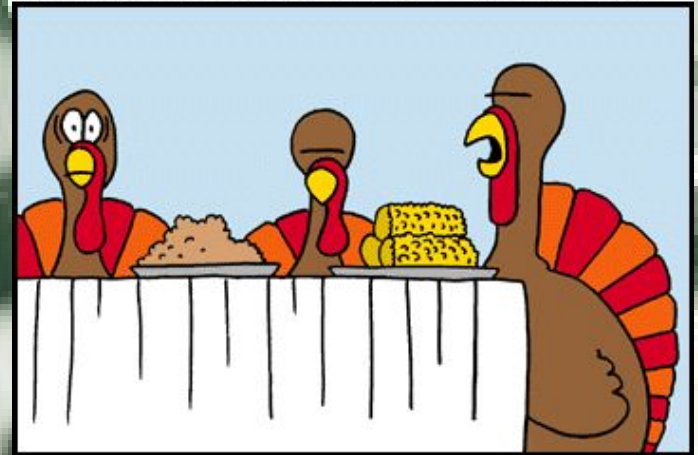

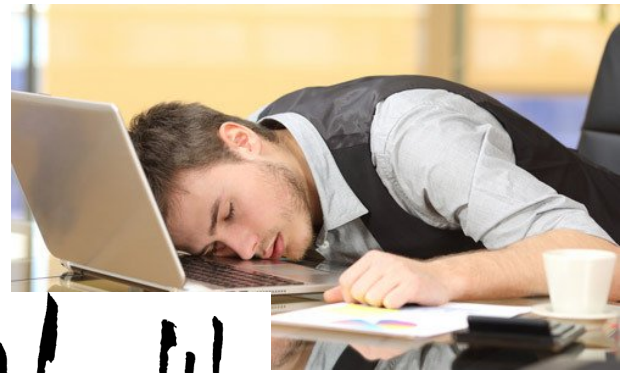

To Your Health

Sleep is a very necessary process of daily living. In sleep mode, our bodies and minds enter a type of stasis in which we process information in the brain (often resulting in dreams) and the body restores itself. That might explain why we sleep so soundly after a day of unusually active physical strain. Yes, we actually heal better during sleep.

The average adult requires between seven and nine hours of sleep each night. We cannot truly store up sleep, but we always must make up sleep. Jet lag throws off our routine and our sleep patterns, resulting in a draggy feeling and a need to sleep at the wrong times. These same feelings can result from poor sleep even when not traveling. A few factors that interfere with good sleep: eating foods before bed that build up stomach acid; emotional stress; frequent bathroom trips during the night; and sleep apnea. The latter is a condition in which the brain allows us to actually stop breathing for a moment, kicking us out of deep sleep throughout the night. There are breathing devices available which allow us to sleep regularly throughout the night, leaving us much more rested in the mornings. See your physician about this.

Setting a good pattern for going to bed can aid in good sleep. Turn off your television at a reasonable time and put away personal devices at an early hour. Allow yourself to relax and ease off into slumber. For ministers, if you are called out in the night for an emergency, sleep in a bit the next day and go in late to the office to allow yourself to function at a solid level for the Lord. When you just can't calm your mind there are over the counter sleep aids that are good for temporary sleeplessness and are not habit forming. God is big on resting. He even set aside a whole day each week for this purpose. Follow the principle.

INSIGHTS FOR GROWTH...

I was speaking at a church recently and was asked "What does a 'Church Development Specialist' do, exactly?" I began explaining my role, they began nodding their head, and I walked away a little troubled. Not that being asked the question bothered me, but that, my role would be unnecessary if we as followers of Christ just learned and applied that which we already know to do. I, nor anyone, carries a magic formula to make churches grow. Take a quick look at the Internet or go into a Christian book store and you will find "solutions" to the problem of church stagnation and dropout. Learned men will come to your area and teach you the "3 Steps To..." Ladies and Gentlemen, short of the power of God on our lives and our obedience to follow what He has already instructed us to do, we aren't going to move the needle! Besides, many times I believe we are focusing on growing the wrong thing. Are we trying to grow an institution or an individual? According to God's Word, we are to grow the person - and if the person spiritually matures and develops, the entire institution will then begin to grow. Many times, I believe we have the formula backwards - Lets apply a formula, a program to the ministry as a whole and somehow, it will trickle down to the individual.

As much as I love my role, I believe it to be unnecessary if we are found faithful. Yes, I



can train your leadership to be better leaders, I can show you how to grow your small groups or how to set up a First Impressions ministry - and will gladly do so! But, lets come together and make the First Thing the first thing. We are familiar with The Great Commission (Matthew 28:18-20, Acts 1:8) given to all naming Christ as King. As powerful and meaningful as The Great Commision, is The Great Commnadment, so, in closing, I wish to leave you with some powerful words from a greatly respected theologian of yesteryear.

Adam Clarke, in his Commentary on the Bible, wrote:

This is the first and great commandment. It is "first and greatest":

1 In its *antiquity*; being as old as the world, and engraved originally on our very nature.

2 In its *dignity*; as directly and immediately proceeding from and referring to God.

3 In its *excellence*; being

the commandment of the new covenant, and the very spirit of the Divine adoption.

4 In its *justice*; because it alone renders to God his due, prefers him before all things, and secures to him his proper rank in relation to them.

5 In its *sufficiency*; being in itself capable of making men holy in this life, and happy in the other.

6 In its *fruitfulness*; because it is the root of all commandments, and the fulfilling of the law.

7 In its *virtue and efficacy*; because by this alone God reigns in the heart of humans, and humans are united to God.

8 In its *extent*; leaving nothing to the creature, which it does not refer to the Creator.

9 In its *necessity*; being absolutely indispensable.

10 In its *duration*; being ever to be continued on earth, and never to be discontinued in heaven.

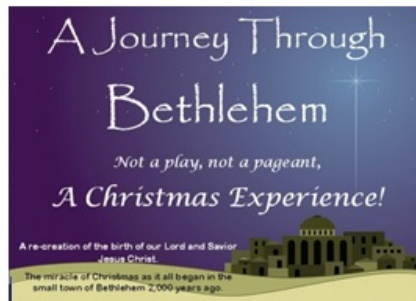

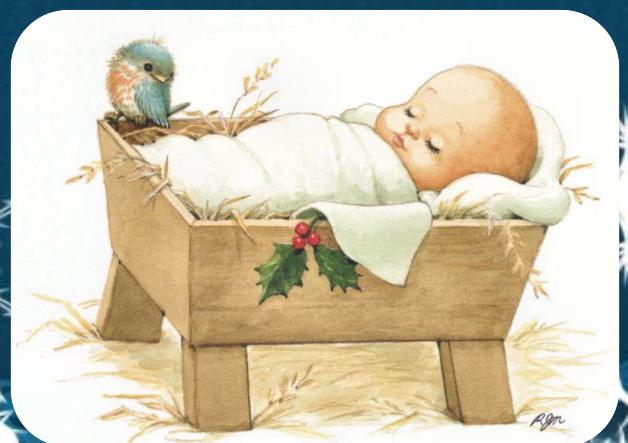

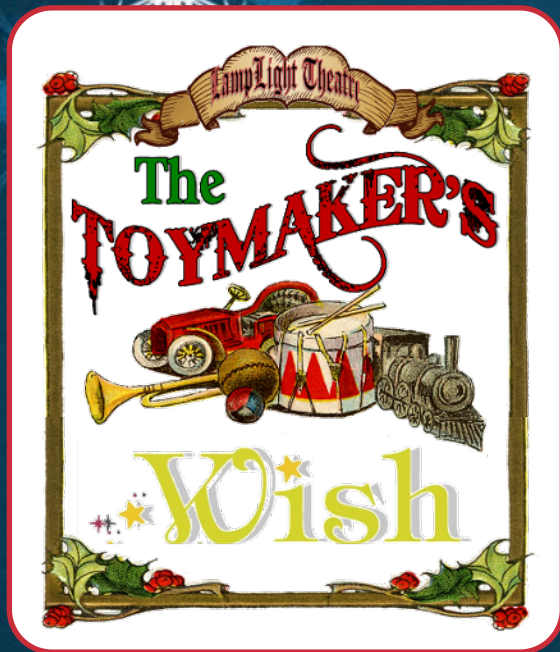
