

# Ben Brags on the Savior

kingdom shall be preached in the whole world as a testimony to all the nations, and then the end will come." Matt. 24:14

In Nepal 1990, two thousand Christians were known; In 1999, over half a million. In 1990, Mozambique had no known Christians; In 1999, there were 300 new churches. In one decade, Asia boomed from 15 million Christians to over 100 million. In South America, 40 thousand evangelicals became 40 million from 1990-99. India had three million conversions during that decade. Even the Muslim world has seen an astronomical increase in converts.

So, what has happened from 2000-2020? Probably 70% or more converts again...in every part of the world except North America, Western Europe, Japan and







Australia!!! WHY???

What is happening worldwide...EXCEPT among people like us?

John Franklin summarizes, they pray earnestly TOGETHER; We talk about praying INDIVIDUALLY.

In the New
Testament, almost
every mention of prayer
most likely refers to
group or corporate
prayer, including Acts
6. In recent centuries,
every awakening has
been preceded by

significant corporate prayer. And the primary common denominator in every part of the world where God is moving mightily today is the priority of PRAYING TOGETHER.

But in America, the centerpiece in most evangelical churches is MINISTRY OF THE WORD...to the near-abandonment of fervent, united, corporate PRAYER...TOGETHER.

Let us not fall to the PRIDE of thinking eloquence and thoroughness in preaching and teaching are all-sufficient. Pastors/Leaders, we must make PRAYING TOGETHER a priority EQUAL to PREACHING and teaching.

Until we get it right on the priority of earnest corporate prayer, we should expect to see continuing decline in societal morals and an increase in powerless churches, and the rest of the world will continue to experience spiritual awakening and



preparation for the Return of Christ... without us.

# Church Health

If you were to type "Average Tenure of Southern Baptist Pastors" into your internet browser you would get plenty of suggestions. Some will say 3-4 years while others will go as high as almost 8 years. There are many factors that go into how long a pastor will stay in a particular pastorate but the bottom line is this: He will not stay there forever! As you read this you may be thinking, "I'm not expecting my pastor to leave anytime soon." and you may be correct. However, the reality is that there will be a day the pulpit at your church will be vacated and what occurs next will have a lot to do with the future of your church.

I am borrowing from an article I read several years ago written by Lavern Brown entitled "9 Signs Your Church Needs an Intentional Interim Pastor." The author made a very good case for every church to consider this step when that day arrives - and it eventually will, that your current pastor leaves.

Calling an intentional interim pastor should be the first thing a church does when the pastor resigns, especially if the church meets any of these criteria:

- 1. The pastor is leaving after a lengthy tenure (experts differ over"lengthy tenure", with figures from 7 to 15 years).
- 2. The church churns its pastors (a new one is called every few years).
- 3. The pastor leaves under duress (forced out) or due to moral failure.
- 4. The church's leaders can't identify or



agree on the church's mission.

- 5. It has been three years since the last ministry audit (everything is reviewed for "mission fit" and amended as needed).
- 6. It is a "commuter church" (members are very different from those who live near the church).
- 7. Attendance has plateaued (people coming in offset those who leave).
- 8. The church faces significant financial challenges.

Any church entering the transition between pastors should pay careful and prayer attention to these danger signs. If not, there is a danger the leadership team might utter five very dangerous words. If these words become a mantra the leadership could unwittingly inflict serious damage on the church that take years to repair.

Five words church leaders must avoid "We can do it ourselves."

Those words should be neither spoken or thought by the leaders of a church that meets any of the criteria. Perhaps this is an appropriate sentiment for church leaders that have the rare good fortune of being part of a robust, vigorous congregation. Other than that, they might say these five deadly words because they don't know what they don't know.


In order to be fully credentialed, you will need to take at least one specialized class after you have taken the prerequisite course of "Introduction to Southern Baptist Disaster Relief."
