THE LONG HAUL

During our recent move I was reminded once again of the difference between stuff we accumulate and things of value. Over the past two weeks we've filled more garbage bags than anyone dared to count. We've sifted through pieces and parts and wondered whether any of them were worth keeping. This laborious process reminds me of the plight of the local church. Even if your church never relocates, it is faced from time to time with the need to sort things and dispose of some of them. Have you ever noticed how many things go to your church's attic, storage room, etc. only to die a slow death and get discarded years later? And yet, there's a more important sorting to be done.

An accumulation of material junk is usually just irritating and illogical. The accumulation of resource wasting programs and projects can be deadly, because sinners die without Jesus every day. So, what is your church doing with its time, energy, and money? Consider the following questions for your church:

What is our mission? (Why are we here?)

What is our vision for fulfilling that mission? (Where are we called to fulfill the mission?)

What are we committing our ministry time to? (Check your church calendar.)

What leaders are we recruiting? (Look at your Nominating Committee sheet.)

How are we spending God's money? (Analyze your budget.)

Do the answers to the questions above point in the same direction? Often a church knows its mission and has at least some degree of vision, but has a calendar, Nominating Committee list, and/or budget that contradicts them. If so, it's time to sort and purge. If you are committed to making disciples in the area where God has planted you, then make sure you are using your time and money for that purpose. Choose leaders to advance the vision instead of merely filling fifty-year-old slots on a piece of paper.

Will this process be easy? Not at all. Some long-held programs and "good causes" will end up in the ministry dumpster. Ten pet projects may give way to three intentional ministries. The strength to complete this thorny process lies in the conviction that your church exists to make fruit-bearing disciples of Jesus Christ. Stuff ends up in the storage room permanently because it serves no purpose for the long haul. In a similar way, certain church programs and activities produce no fruit because they don't match your unchanging mission. Do you have the courage and conviction to clean out the ministry storage room?
